Hollow figurine fragment which includes the central portion of a face. There is no fine core, fine clouding, or surface burning. The face includes a large, triangular, applied nose - sharply ridged along the top, slightly raised ^{left} eyes - only faintly defined, large, wavy meandering lips, a representation of two front incisors - formed by incision, and a chin which was accentuated by a groove 17 mm wide + .3 cm deep. The curvature of the face is also quite pronounced; the fragment forms one sixth of a sphere. The lower lip protrudes more than the upper lip and there is a marked indentation of the lip below the septum. The exterior surface is very smooth, although slightly worn. The interior surface is rougher - there are more lumps and unevenly distributed bits of clay, but it has a slightly silky feeling to it as well. The design appears to have been formed by modeling, molding, applique and incision. There is no slip or paint.
