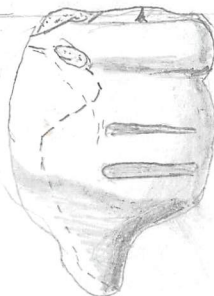

Effigy Candelero

This example includes a candelero with two vertical grooves and a horizontal groove separating the base from the rim. The top surface has 3 punctated spheres representing openings in the candelero. The right hand of the figure holds the candelero with 3 fingers & a thumb (shorter than the 3 fingers) being defined by 3 horizontal grooves. Space beneath the candelero is recessed. Intern surface is very jagged. deep impression behind the occiput rim. No paint, slip or fire damage.
