VERBAL DESCRIPTION:

Frag of a solid, modeled figurine with a pierced hole which may have been used to suspend the figurine as a pectoral. This part contains the top of the headdress. It is hand-made (by impressions) there is a punctated, applied puffy doughnut circle in the upper center, there is a flattered dish on the top center. There is an applied band outlining the right half of the headdress (as preserved). There are two rectangular flanges - one on either side - the back is smooth and convex. It looks as if the figurine head & body may have been hollow. The base of the headdress curves upwards concavely. It is smooth - not fractured. ^{There is} a ring on the top portion of the headdress & it includes the break so it was burnt after breaking. The back is also burnt. No firing cone, paint, or slip.
