VERBAL DESCRIPTION:

Solid, mold made fragment of a hollow figurine with most of the face + headdress. This frag is all solid but there is an attachment for a hollow body at the neck. The headdress has a central, raised, wide band w/ additional decoration flanked by a thin, raised band above + below. Each of these is set off by a groove. There is a punctated, puffy doughnut earflap present in the right ear, there are elevated, puffy eyebrows, eyes have puffy margins (not enough sleep) with punctated pupils, nose is large + triangular, lips are puffy + there is an undifferentiated - non incised - "T" tooth in upper right (fing right) corner of headdress, no fin cloud in upper right (fing right) corner of headdress, NO paint or slip. Back is flat.
