Fragment of a hollow, mold-made, anthropomorphic fig frag. with  
- Very nicely crafted portion of a headdress, forehead, eye, eyelid and nose  
Scar. The headdress has a band with vertical incision - very finely done -  
the band is surmounted by a squared, puffy field with the beginning of  
a central design along the margin. There are 3 hor lines, a diagonally incised  
eyelid, a slit eye with a puffy, elongated iris & a punctated eye  
There is also a nose-scar. No paint, slip, base chalking, burning. fig con  
extends from interior to interior. Scar of exterior surface.
