Verbal Description:

This is a facial fragment, but it is not purely anthropomorphic in nature. The figurine's face is raised and centrally cleft. The eyes, which are almond-shaped with singly punctated pupils, are sunken into the face, oriented on the diagonals of the face and wide set. The nose (which has been sheared off) appears to have been more or less triangular, the cheeks are large & joint-like, the mouth has raised lips set off from the remainder of the face by a groove. The inside of the head has faint marks - it may be a portion of a spherical sandy chamber.
