VERBAL DESCRIPTION:

Hollow mold-made anthropomorphic fig frag. with part of a
trigonal-flanged headdress with a very long, punctated puffy-doughnut
earflange. The headdress has light vertical incisions on the flange which
swaps out past the ear flange large fig core - from interior surface
to within 3/4 in of exterior wall. No lining, clay slip or paint.
