## Verbal Description:

There is evidence of at least 3 chambers that looked to have been round w/ roughly smoothed + curved walls and rounded or irregular bottoms. The chambers and paste are extremely burnt. There is evidence of one small rnd vent hole in the exterior wall, <sup>near the center - about the feet ca. 1/2 way up the wall</sup>. The exterior surfaces are roughly smoothed w/ lots of visible temper. The walls seem like they may have been roughly flat. The base has 2 ~~extant~~ extant small nubbin feet, each roughly near a corner + under a chamber.
