Verbal Description:

This is a complete candelero. It has 4 little solid nubbin like feet, one at each corner. It also has 4 chambers one also in each corner. The chambers are roughly round in shape. The exterior walls are basically flat, undulating slightly with the chambers. The corners are rounded, not sharp, and at each corner there is a small round vent hole in the exterior wall.
