Verbal Description:

fragment of multichamber candelero w/ evidence of at least 3 Chambers. The chamber walls are smooth + curved if slightly irregular and look like they were wider at the bottom. All chambers are burnt + fireclouded, most heavily at the bottom. Exterior is fairly well smoothed and the walls undulate with the chambers. There is one extant nubbin foot at the bottom of the most complete chamber. It is possible to see that it was made by inserting a plug of clay into a hole in the chamber bottom + then smoothing over the ^{exterior} ~~foot~~ to make the foot.
