Verbal Description:

- This is a fragment of a candelero with evidence of at least 2 chambers. The top of the fragment is well flattened. The exterior wall is well smoothed + undulates only slightly with the chambers. There are no visible vents. The chamber walls are smooth + well rounded + look like they probably had a flat bottom. The chambers are burnt black in the bottom 1/3 are fireclouded white in the center + pretty much normal paste color in the top 1/3.
