Verbal Description:

Clear evidence of only one chamber with smooth wall and flat bottom and evidence of both burning and fireclay. There are two round vent holes $\frac{1}{2}$ way up the wall they were made by pushing something from the exterior to the interior. The rim is thin + well finished. The exterior wall is very smoothed and is incised with a thin lined design of an X in an open box



It also has a slightly conical foot that is taller than the normal nubbins on candeleros.
