VERBAL DESCRIPTION: This is a whole - fragmentary candelero. There are 1 whole and / or 3 partial chambers preserved.

Chamber diameter(s) is - are: 13.1 mm, 11.7, 13.8 mm

Chamber depth(s) is - are: 38.5 mm, 35.7 mm

Chambers are - are not burned in the interior. Bottom 1/4 of chamber is burnt. Some burning extends into interior walls.

Other information about chambers:

Vents are - are not present. If present, describe:

Diam: 3.0 mm Located 1/2 way up exterior wall

Exterior wall is - is not preserved. If present, wall is: straight/vertical - straight/outslanted - convex.

Exterior surface is smooth - rough - striated - irregular - undulating - gouged - pitted - finger-marked.

Basal edge is - is not preserved. If present, it is rounded - right-angled (or close to it).
