The interior shows the following manufacturing marks: none - smoothing - wiping - finger smears - finger prints - scraping - striations - lumps of clay - seams from molding - trimming - other (describe).

The exterior shows the following treatments: incision - excision - slip - paint - smoothing - burnishing - polishing - other (describe). Slip and/or paint colors are (Munsell designations):

Appliqueed portions are present y or n. Describe if present: The nostrils on the large nose.

The large nose was also appliqueed onto the larger figurine face.

Describe the figurative or decorative portion of the exterior:

fragment from a large face. The only facial features preserved are the large appliqueed on nose + very eroded incised ^{right} eye. No other facial features on the left side of the appliqueed nose. The nose + nostrils aren't very eroded but the eye on the figurine itself is very eroded + it's hard to determine what all the little lines around the pupil are suppose to signify... perhaps simply wrinkles b/w the eye + nose.

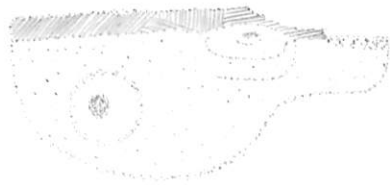
