The chamber has: no 1 - 2 - 3 - more (give number) fingering holes. Their diameters are: $\phi . 4$

The mouthpiece: is - is not a typical square mouthpiece. If not, describe.

The air passage in the mouthpiece measures: cm by cm.

The rectangular sound hole measures: cm by cm.

The interior of the mouthpiece: does - does - cannot tell not have a "chocolate curl" from manufacturing.
