The headdress is a flat-topped, raised-band headdress with curved ends that end slightly above the parietal spine level (equal on the main margin). The eyes are slits w/ pupil pupils + nasal margin. The nose is broken, the mouth is gone

The item is: not eroded - slightly - moderately - extremely - eroded.

The item is: not drawn - drawn. Where?

Comments: The head is solid, the base is flat. No fig core, paint or slip.
