Special: moderately coarse paste with numerous small white inclusions - primary core is variable - 3 of the strands show slight darkening toward the center while in the 4th the dark block core takes up almost the whole thickness of the strand (~~102~~ ^{2.542} 618). Exterior is well-smoothed, interior is lightly smoothed (~~102~~ ⁵⁴² 614). Slight evidence of orange slipping extending down to at least 4.9cm from the rim on the interior; red slipping on the exterior, becoming blotchy/spotty towards the base. A 0.5cm wide x 0.1cm deep groove, cut prior to slipping, runs circumferentially just above the floor base (102 518, slip.)
