Describe the figurative or decorative portion of the exterior:

Fragment of an eye from a very large figurine face. More than likely the vessels left eye. Creases around the ~~eye~~ forehead + eye area have been incised. The outline of the eye has been excised + the pupil has been poked all the way through to the other side creating chocolate curls on the inside. The brow ridge + part of forehead is present + is simply shaped, but no features are carved in. A ~~part~~ portion of the left cheek is also preserved under the eye.
