Between the elbow & wrist is a wristlet composed of diamonds with dots in the centers. Only 4 digits are shown; all are square

Other interesting, useful info: and blunt, with no nails or knuckles. Leg seems to be bent, with arm just above probable knee. The projection at the base of the leg, presumably a foot, is not realistic: there are at least 8 short lines dividing it into what looks like fringe, not a foot or toes.

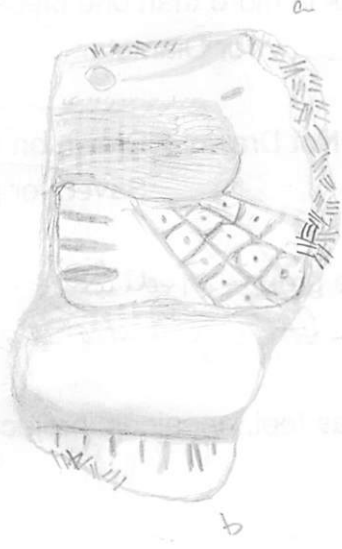
