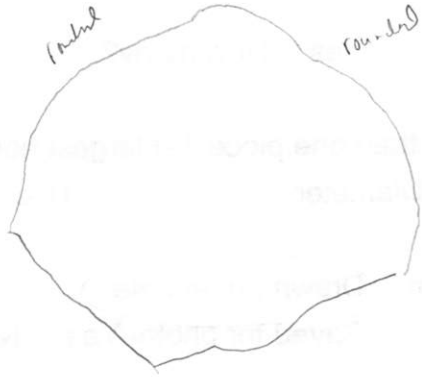
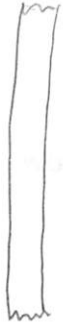
While the entire piece seems to be rounded in shape, it is not totally circular. The edges are not finished & where smooth appear to be so more from finish than anything else.
