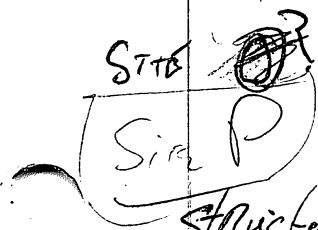

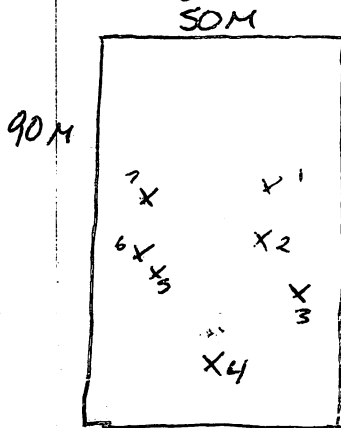

Site ↓, seven structures flagged. 150 ~~west~~^{nise} is a KARAKA, 300 m north of The main LA SIERRA Site group. Sites lie below a NATURAL^{nise} THAT does not appear to contain any ~~sites~~ structures. Structures rather undefined on first glance. Overall field dimensions are about 90 m x 50 D-E. Grass is 20 cm length, Access ~~road~~ 50 m to the west of the site. The structures form a U shape oriented Northwest to Southeast with the point in the Southeast direction. All structures with the exceptions of 1, 2 and 7 show greater height on their southern portions.



About Vegetation Thickened over the sites. Undefined Access Road running between 1, 2, 3 and 4-7, doesn't look like it had any destructive effect on the sites. Overall not too impressive

Site group P

6 structures separated by a road through the center. 5 of the structures are north of the road, 1 is to the south of the road. In the road itself are two clumps of river cobbles. The western clump is 5m in diameter the eastern clump is 1.5. The northern section of the site was situated in a cow pasture. All sites with the exception of IV were fairly well defined.

This is an overview of the fields surveyed on Friday the 12th, 3, 9 and 12. ~~At first~~ we started on first on the field 3 ~~fields~~ west of the farm on the north side of the cowpath. This was over an area about 200 m. west of the farm. Our method of survey was to place ourselves from south to north about 20m apart and move west, then move over and proceed in an easterly direction. We did this for 3 consecutive fields due west and then usually surveyed the next two toward the west.

Site S.

The field is in the western most portion of the cow farm property, directly south of the cow path. Grass 50cm high field 100m N to S. 50m East to west. 7 structures tentatively. Form an elliptical on a westerly rise. 300 northwest of KABRADA. 175 west of Site Q. 1 km Northwest of LA SIERRA main site group. 1.2 north west of ~~the~~ River. Horse pastures. Intermittent tree cover. Structures located ~~northwest~~ ~~near~~ west middle portion of the field. The rise also rises going south.

The most defined structure group in the site is probably numbers 4 and 5 in which clearly defined walls can be clearly made out. The least defined site is number 1 which has a tree over what might be a grande ~~site~~ terrace patio extending from the main group.

I ALSO WENT TO THE EAST OF ~~SITE~~ THE 2ND AND 3RD FIELDS AND FOUND NOTHING THERE. ON SURVEY I ASSISTED IN THE SKETCH MAP OF SITE U, WHICH CONTAINED 34 STRUCTURES. THE SITE WAS IN AN ELLIPTICAL FACING NORTHWEST. THE MOST INTRIGUING OF THE SITE'S STRUCTURES ARE ON A PLATFORM WHICH CONTAINS FOUR STRUCTURES. THE TERRACES EXTEND TO THE EAST AND THE NORTH. THIS MULTI-STRUCTURE PLATFORM IS IN THE NORTHWEST FIELD WHICH HAS APPROXIMATELY 10 STRUCTURES.

In the morning Dave and I performed a structure survey and flagged close to 15 structures. In La Sierra 2 overall there are approximately 25 structures. The furthest east of these structures is approximately 30 meters ~~east~~ west of the river. The largest of the sites is about 4 meters in height and one structure is possibly 20 meters in length.

Have surveyed 6 fields East of the LA Sierra main site group and 5 more fields to the north. Finally we reached LA Sierra ~~main~~ group S. We are ~~at~~ 400m north west of Chamelegon, $\frac{1}{2}$ k south of LA Sierra main site group. Overall the site is on a natural rise of about 3 meters. There are 7 structures on top of this hill. The largest of them was about 2.5 meters high. 6 of the structures face the largest structure, which is oriented in the northwest of the cluster. As for the other fields, we found loose cobbles but figured they were alluvial deposits from past flood season. The rise that these structures are built upon extends around the whole site. The dimensions of the rise are about 25m N-S, 45 E-W.

FEB. 24

Have found that LA Sierra S was not on an actual rise, as we first assumed, it is actually found to be built upon a platform which at certain points is as much as much as 2 meters high. Are taking transit points on the bottom and the top points of the terrace. ~~The~~ Rain however, finished off this venture rather quickly.

Half day, did new lots on 10L, and performed those functions for the remainder of the day.

Overall we surveyed approximately 20 fields. In the morning, Nancy, Chris, Lavinia, Lisa and myself did around 10 fields on the north side of the river and moved in a westerly direction. Failed to find any structures. There was a road that defined the north boundary of our area covered and the Chamelecon was served as our southern boundary. In the afternoon Chris and David marked more structures which will be mapped ~~later~~ tomorrow.

Unit 2 lies approximately .16 m to the west of unit 1 and is composed of sheet rock. Utilized most likely as a platform, unit II is set up in three courses north to south. The height of the unit is approximately .12 m and it tilts down approximately .05 m. The fact that the tilt down occurs at the western part of the platform rather than the eastern is possibly the result of summit ?? decay during the post occupation decay of the structure. Tumble is most prevalent in the western part of the structure which might have served to the downward tilt on the western rather than the eastern side of the **shist leoch** ?? The summit was not probed.

Time Span I:

This time span involved the abandonment structure and the laying down of structure I. ~~XX~~ Composed of a sort of gray ashen soil, stratum 1 shows an average thickness of .15m. Feature I, located at the western edge of the trench and directly west of unit II was composed of large unmodified river cobbles and reaches a height of .40. and a width of 1.60 m. Feature II was located just east of unit I and was also composed largely from unmodified river cobbles. Height averaged around .45m with a width of .90m.

New Structure 144

Structure 144 is a rectangular platform that protrudes approximately

2.0 m above ground surface: this structure was investigated by means of an 8.0 trench into the east face of the structure labeled 23A. Excavations performed were to determine the location of the basal wall and other walls above it. The summit was not investigated. Excavated in 1.0 (E.W.) 32 by 1.0 N.S. increments structure 145 was investigated over a three day period by 2 workers for 6 man/days labour expense which located a total of five walls.

Time Span III:

Stratum I was located between 2.15 and 2.65 below the summit's surface and showed a maximum thickness of .40m. composed of a light brown chalky soil. This time span contained no evidence indicating prior cultural activity earlier than in the final occupation.

Stratum II, located between 1.90 and 2.15 below the summit's surface and composed of a darker slightly more coarse soil is also without evidence of previous structural activity and is thus included in the initial time span.

Time Span II:

This time span was involved in the laying down of units I through V and its associated features located within stratum III, a dark brown soil located between .90m and the summit's surface, structure 203's walls are composed of cut blocks which make it somewhat of an anomaly in comparison to the western excavations of La Sierra. Unit I, the basal wall of the structure was excavated to a height of .10 M and a horizontal length of .20m composed of thin cut blocks located at a depth between 1.60 and 1.50. This first unit might have composed an initial step up to a platform leading to unit II. This platform extends .60m south of I and is composed of flat cobble stones. Unit II, .60m south of unit I is composed of cut blocks that have been exposed to a height .18 and a horizontal extent of .55m. By 35m. what is the most intriguing feature of unit II is the fact that it is the only wall in the whole structure that has its block placement upright rather than on their sides. Exposed in the excavations at a corner, unit II once again shows a departure from the other units.

Units 3 through 5 are constructed as a three tiered set of steps located between .90m and 2.0m south of unit II. These three units are all composed of cut blocks laid flat - unit III the northernmost of the walls was excavated to a preserved height of .10m and extended horizontally .20m. Its depth was between 1.04 and 1.14 below the summit's surface. Unit IV, .20M

This rather unconventional method of cut block placement has nevertheless been noted in other structures. Over all the unit deviated

from an upright vertical placement by approximately .04 this unit was excavated at a depth between 1.60 and 1.20 below the summits surface.

West of the eastern edge of unit III, ?? was excavated to a preserved height of .20 with a horizontal extent of .40m excavated at a depth between .84 and 1.04 below the summit's surface. Unit IV limestone blocks averaged .10m by .40 m and were constructed one atop the other. Unit V, located approximately .40 M west on the eastern edge of unit IV is comprised of larger blocks than the previous two units approximately .15 - .20 by .40 m and deviates from its vertical center by approximately .05 M. this unit located between .50 and .34 below summits surfaces followed by a three meter feature that appears to have reached its present resting place as a result of the post-occupational decay of the summit.

Time span I

Composed of the same soil of stratum 3, time span is composed of the overburden ?? that covered structure 144 its post-terminal occupation decay.

New 145:

Structure 145 is a large rectangular structure protruding 2.0 meters above ground surface. It was investigated in 1988 by means of an 8 m trench into the North face of the structure. The purpose of excavations was to probe the basal construction and other walls that preceded the summit of the structure. The trench excavated extended 1.0 m E.W. by 8.0 m. north-south. It was excavated over a three day period by 2 men for six days worked.

Time span III:

Stratum I located between 1.70 and 2.10m below the summits surface and was composed of a light brown hard soil. It was exposed to a maximum thickness of .42 m and contained no evidence of occupational activity prior or during the final occupation of the structure.

Time span II:

Stratum II, composed of dark crumbly soil, was exposed to a thickness of 1.60m between 1.60 m and the summit. Found approximately 2.1 m north of the vertical rise of the structure was a spongy shell. This type of shell, an anomaly in the area, was often used in religious ritual. This shell most likely reached its present location as a result of post-occupational decay of the structure.

Unit I of structure 145 is located at a depth of 1.40m below the summit's surface, reaches a preserved height of .15m. It is composed of unmodified river cobbles. It appears the initial wall in a three tiered terrace system lying .32m south of the northernmost edge of unit I. Composed also of cobble, unit was exposed to a preserved height of .15m between 1.0 m and 1.15m below the summit's surface. The final tier of this terrace system, unit III lies .30 south of the northernmost edge of unit II was exposed to a preserved height of .15m between .50m and .95m below the summit's surface. The cobbles that comprise all three levels average .30m by .10-.15 m per block.

Following the three tiered terrace lies unit IV approximately 1.10 south of the northernmost edge of unit III. Exposed to a preserved height of approximately .60m between .90 and .40 below the summit's surface. Unit IV is composed of large cobbles placed one atop another in three levels. The unit has its post-occupational decay swayed approximately .05 south of its original vertical stance.

Time span I

This time span involved the abandonment of structure 145 and the laying down of feature I. Composed mainly of large river cobbles; feature I extends 2.20 meters and shows an approximate thickness of .70m. Overall the dirt of stratum II was prevalent in the matrix of the feature I

New 203:

Structure 203 is a rectangular platform rising approximately 1.5m above ground surface. 1988 excavations were performed by means of a 6.5m trench into the southern face of the structure. This operation was dug to determine the basal architecture and other walls and or features that preceded the summit. The trench measured 6.5m E-W by 1.0M N-S. and was excavated by two men over a three day period for six man/days labour expended.

Time span III

Located between 1.02 and 1.30 below the summits surface and composed of a dark brown clay stratum gave no indication of previous occupation.

Time span II

Stratum II is located between 1.60m and up to the summit's surface and is composed of a light brown land soil. Unit I was excavated in a matrix of stratum II's soil and showed a preserved height of .30m and was

located between .60 and .90 below the summits surface. It is composed of unmodified river cobbles averaging .20m by .30m. Unit II, composed of similarly sized river cobbles, lies 1.20m north of the southernmost edge of unit I, on the basal wall. This wall stood to a preserved height of .21 and was located between .85m and 1.06m below the summit's surface. Unit III is located approximately 1.20 north of the southernmost edge of unit II, composed of large river cobbles slightly bigger than those used in the two previous units, this unit reaches its preserved height of .80m through four layer rows of cobbles. Unit III's overall height is shortened by a vertical deviance of approximately .12m. As it is the largest wall of the three units excavated and is the closest to the summit, it is conjecturable that this wall might have held up a platform on the summit. The summit's severe decay renders this question mute however.

Time span I

Time span involved the abandonment of structure 203 and the laying down of feature I. Spreading over a 3.8m horizontal extent and showing a maximum thickness of .70 m, Feature I is largely composed of large river cobbles that would seem to have tumbled during post-occupational decay. Overburden is of the same soil type of stratum 2.

New Structure 230:

Structure 230 protrudes 2.0 meters above ground surface in the western portion of La Sierra. 1988 Investigations consisted of a 6.5m trench into the western face of the platform. Clearing operations involved removal of overburden revealing two walls. Excavations proceeded in 1m x 1m increments moving W to E beginning 3.8 m W. of the vertical rise of the structure. The purpose of the trench was to be terminal phase architecture and associated activities and to cut down in front of construction in search of earlier occupational levels. Structure 230 was excavated for a total of 6 days with 2 workers a total of 12 man/days of labour.

Time span 4

Composed of a hard coarse dark brown soil, stratum 6 was located between 2.40 and 2.80m below the summits surface. Exposed to a thickness of .40 on the easternmost portion. This stratum contained no evidence of occupation.

Time span 3

Composed of a lighter brown but still coarse soil, stratum 5 gives clear

evidence of human presence. Located between 2.20 and 2.30m below the summit's surface is an undulating level of Baja Regue .52m long and between .04 and .10m thick. The recovered Baja Regue may have been a remnant from a floor. Stratum 4's soil level is approximately .30m thick and located between 2.10 and 2.40 below ground surface. Stratum 4 maintains a lighter brown color than its underlying level but maintains its hard and coarse quality. Located between 1.80 and 2.10m below the summit's surface and exposed to a maximum thickness of .33 stratum 3 contained occupational evidence in the form of pottery shards. These shards were found between 1.50 and 2.40m below the ground surface mostly in the three meters west of the vertical rise. It would appear probable that these shards in association with a previous occupation rather than in structure 230's terminal use. Stratum 3's soil level shows a marked those below it in its lighter grey color and ashen texture. Located between 1.10 and 1.50m below the summit's surface. This level was exposed to a maximum thickness of .35 m located within its matrix were bones and shards. It would appear in this stratum as in the previous one that these artifacts were probably not in association with the final occupation.

Time span 2

Stratum 2, located between 1.10 and the summit's surface, was exposed to a maximum thickness of .36m and was composed of the same ashen grey soil as stratum 2. Found in the eastern most section of the trench within this stratum were various obsidian blades and a cover. It would appear that these cores were part of terminal occupation and most likely reached their present location as a result of the decay of structure 230 during its post-terminal stage. Unit I of structure 230 was fully excavated to a height of .40 between 1.88 and 2.10 east of the western extent of the trench. Constructed of unmodified river cobbles and set in two east west courses, the basal wall tilts out eastward deviating .05m from its center point.
