VERBAL DESCRIPTION: This is a whole fragmentary candelero. There are 2 whole and / or partial chambers preserved.

Chamber diameter(s) is - are: can't tell

Chamber depth(s) is - are: 2.5cm, 3.7cm.

Chambers are - are not burned in the interior. Burnt up to the top.

Other information about chambers: Inward tapering walls, rounded bases

Vents are - are not present. If present, describe: 1 chamber, 2.3cm x 2.2cm above the base, 0.3cm in diameter (the one measurable example), no smoke

Exterior wall (is) - is not preserved. If present, wall is: straight/vertical straight/outslanted convex. plumes

Exterior surface is smooth - rough - striated - irregular - undulating - gouged - pitted - finger-marked.
