The - upper - lower - both (neither) edge(s) is/are chipped Erosion => Difficulty Baked clay

Clay from making other vessels is baked on the exterior - interior (both sides) - neither side

How many layers of clay are there? 1 - more than one (give the number): at least 2

Comments: No firing core. The small interior globules near the firing patches of the rim suggest this stand layed perpendicular to the ground & was close to it. The exterior displays many layers of thick globules.
