The interior is striated: vertically - horizontally - in various directions - other (describe)

The interior is also smoothed - irregular - undulating - rough - cracked - gouged - pitted - fireclouded,  
and/or has "wet-look" finger marks - clay scraps - mat marking - other (describe).

The exterior is striated: vertically - horizontally - in various directions - other (describe)

The exterior is also smoothed - irregular - undulating - rough - cracked - gouged - pitted - fireclouded,  
and/or has "wet-look" finger marks - clay scraps - other (describe).

There is cut-out decoration preserved: y / n. If present, cut-outs seem to be: triangular - rectangular -
