VERBAL DESCRIPTION: This is a whole / partial complex censer prong. This piece is from: near the bowl - the middle - the distal, pointed end - a whole profile. A part of the bowl/plate area is - is not attached.

There is - is not a vent hole. Diameter: .62 cm

If a distal end, it is flattened - rounded - pointed. The pointed end is - is not worn or abraded.

There are - are not darkened/burnt areas. Where? ←
