VERBAL DESCRIPTION: This is a whole partial complex censer prong. This piece is from: near the bowl - the middle - the distal, pointed end - a whole profile. A part of the bowl/plate area is - is not attached.

There is - is not a vent hole. Diameter: unknown - broken along hole

If a distal end, it is flattened - rounded - pointed. The pointed end is - is not worn or abraded. N/A

There are - are not darkened/burnt areas. Where? on slip near catalog number

There are - are not orange or red blotches. Where?

There is - is not a firing core. If present it is centrally located - shifted towards interior.

The exterior is smoothed - striated - brushed - lumpy - uneven (undulating) other (describe).
