VERBAL DESCRIPTION: This is a whole / partial complex censer prong. This piece is from near the bowl - the middle - the distal, pointed end - a whole profile. A part of the bowl/plate area is is not attached.

If a distal end, it is flattened - rounded - pointed. The pointed end is - is not worn or abraded.
