LEFT EAR, MOUTH, NOSE, LEFT EYE, LEFT SIDE OF FOREHEAD.

EAR: 7cm TALL x 3.2cm WIDE. SOLID EARSPool (4.3cm LONG x 1.4cm THICK) "PASSES THROUGH" THE EAR LOBE. THE UPPER PART OF THE EAR HAS A HOLE 1.4cm WIDE THROUGH IT.

MOUTH: 5.6cm WIDE x 3cm TALL. OVAL. OPEN. MOUTH IS HOLLOW WITH THE EXCEPTION OF 4 UPPER TEETH & ONE LOWER TOOTH. ~~THE~~ OF THE UPPER TEETH, THE TWO OUTER INCISORS ARE 1.1cm WIDE x 1cm LONG AND THE INNER INCISORS ARE 0.75cm WIDE x 1.1cm LONG. THE LOWER "TOOTH" IS MORE A CURL OF CLAY COMING UP FROM THE LOWER LIP TO JOIN THE MIDDLE INCISORS. UPS ARE RAISED 0.5cm FROM FACE.

Comments: TRACES OF ORANGE (5YR 7/6) AND RED (7.5R 5/6) PAINT
EARTH COLORS 10YR 8/3

→ LEFT EYE: 3.6cm x 1.7cm. OVAL IN SHAPE. PUPIL IS 1.1cm ACROSS AND HOLLOW (INCISED EXTERIOR TO INTERIOR. EYE IS SET IN 0.45cm FROM FACE.

NOSE: 3.5cm LONG x 5.5cm TALL x 2.2cm WIDE. ~~PROFILE~~ PROFILE IS ARCHED, NOSE IS GENERALLY NARROW AND POINTY.

EYEBROWS: BOTH ARE PRONOUNCED 8.2cm LONG x 1.1cm WIDE, PROTRUDING 1.3cm OFF FACE. SEPARATED FROM EACH OTHER BY TWO VERTICAL PARALLEL INCISED LINES 2cm LONG x 0.2cm WIDE.

HEADBAND: BAND IS 1.75cm WIDE. IN THE CENTER OF THE FOREHEAD A LOOPED KNOT COMES DOWN ACROSS THE BAND. LOOP IS 1.1cm WIDE.
