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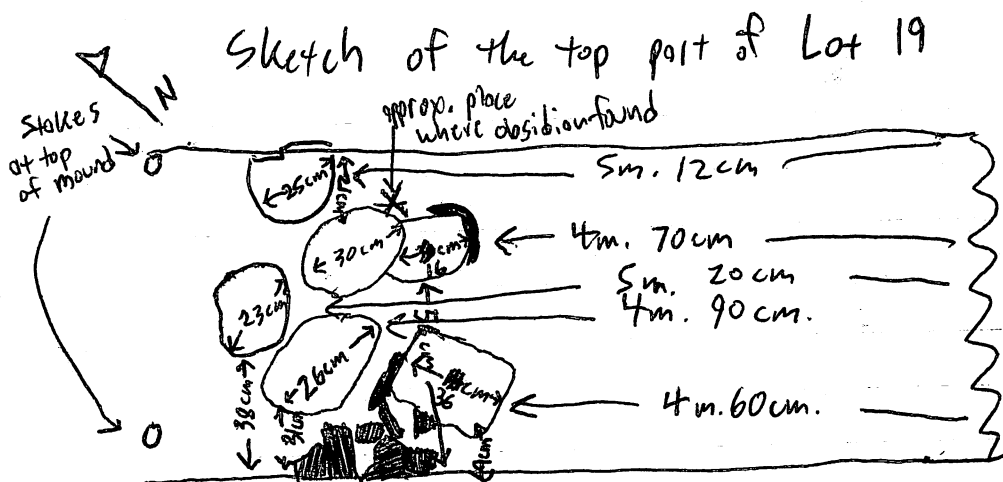

Continued removing loose dirt from ground sherd concentration. A large stone is covering part of the sherd concentration. This stone will be removed in order to better define the concentration. Flakes of carbon, 1 to 2 cm. in diameter, have been appearing but in no single concentration. 1 Broken piece of obsidian recovered.



■ = sherd or sherd concentration

□ = Large cobbles or building stones.

The large cobbles and cut stone look as if they have fallen on to a living floor. This is a tentative explanation of this point.

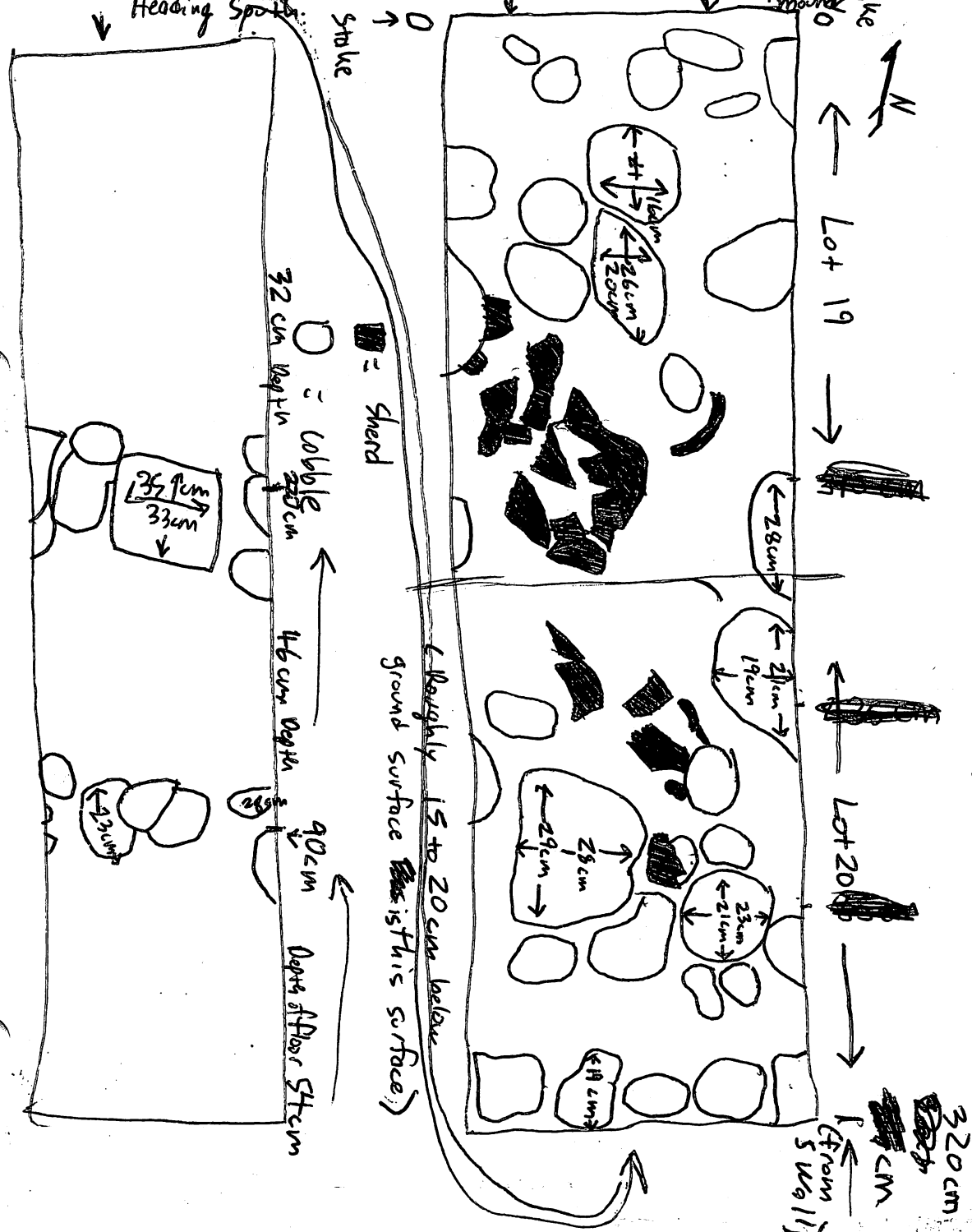
The stones and cobbles illustrated in the above diagram were removed one by one to look more closely at the sherd concentrations. A couple of small animal bones were recovered. The large cut stone (36cm in diagram) was removed and under it was a group of large sherds. They may be eligible for reconstruction. Small pieces of carbon are still being recovered. ~~A broken small piece of obsidian was recovered on the lot floor and left in situ for the photograph.~~

Lot 20. - Excavation is being continued across the top of Subop 12 A on the S side of the summit. A chert flake was recovered. A lot of small sherds continue to turn up as well as a few more concentrations (of sherds)

12A - Northern extension, Lot 22, trying to define the basil was as well as possible connection with structure 12B

12B - Same excavation procedure as defined in 12A 22. Decision will be made as to whether to continue in these areas or expand overall excavation area.

12B - Excavation will continue to the North to try and better define the southern basil wall and terraces.

12A - Excavation will continue to the south to better define the Northern terraces of 12A.

12A 23 - Rubble being removed to define structure features. As rubble was removed a wall was uncovered. The top of the wall is 41cm below ground surface and is 88cm from the North wall.

12B 16 - Rubble being removed to define SKAMP features. High sherd concentration. Just within 12A and 12B, sherd concentration seems to be higher on the South faces of the mounds.

12A 24 - This excavation was undertaken to find additional wall on the north face of the mound. A large rectangular cut-block stone was removed, Its dimensions are 46cm by 32cm

15A-13 Continued removing rubble while looking for structural features.

12B 17 Continued excavation to find ~~the~~ architectural features. No clear features have been defined on the S side of trench 12B



15 A 13 - A wall was encountered as surface rubble was being removed. The wall is 127 cm from the S wall of trench 15 A.

12 B 18 = Excavation undertaken near the north end of the trench. Excavation is to uncover East-West wall ~~called~~ called cauliflower and further determine its shape.

15 A 13 The wall encountered at the S end of 15 A has a large piece of cut stone lying over it. This stone partially obscures ones vision of the wall. Lot B excavation will continue to further define this wall on the N side. The size of the cut block is 33 cm - 38 cm - 8 cm.

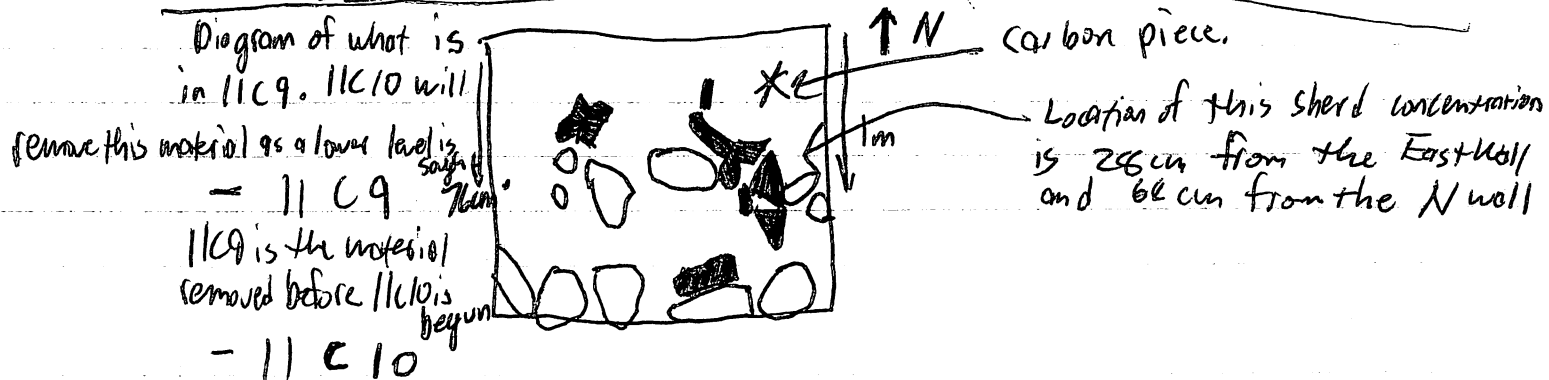

- 11 C 8 A small concentration of carbon has been uncovered. Its location is 20 cm from the East wall, 30 cm from the North wall and 17 cm ~~from~~ below ground surface. Carbon could be further evidence of living surface. Carbon is left in place, the rest of the living floor will be exposed so it may be dealt with as a whole.
- 12 A 24 Continuing cleaning to better define structural elements. A broken, but almost complete, obsidian blade was recovered during the cleaning.
- 15 A 17- Continued excavating toward the north along the west wall of the trench. What was earlier thought to be a wall, then not a wall, has regained wall status yet again. Lot 17 begins 150 to 180 cm from the South wall and 40 cm out from the west wall and is 40 to 50 cm deep.

Notes on Cut Stone. - It seems to having fallen, possibly from a vertical position to its present position which is laying horizontally and very fragmented. It is in close association with a punitive wall that runs north south.

This punitive wall is a possible Bench and the shattered Cut block may have been its Back. The Cut Block is uniformly 10cm thick. The Cut Block seems to be resting directly on the rocks it covers. At most there is 5 cm of dirt between the cut block and the rest of the structure.

When the cut block was removed only a few sherds were found, they will be kept separate for possible dating. They are in Lot 15A27 Separately Bagged.

Site # 266 Site is located on ~~the~~ Reiner's land East of San Bartolo Rio and North of the main <sup>road</sup> running through the valley. The site contains 15 or 20 mounds that are surely prehistoric. However, the site contains numerous (50 or so) small mounds of rocks that are of dubious origin. They could very well be prehistoric but there is the very real possibility that they are historic in origin. They may be the result of some sort of field clearing operation by the landowners in the past, removing rocks ~~from~~ scattered around on the fields into piles to make crop planting or cattle grazing easier or something. There may have been quite a scatter of alluvial rocks in this area due to the location of the site in the San Bartolo flood plain. Although the rio shows no evidence of being able to fill its own bed with water at this time, it may have <sup>once</sup> been able to flood when the valley was ~~water~~ <sup>water</sup> than it is now.

(Descriptions of individual mounds that warrant it)

- #6 Structure is roughly <sup>(N-S) (E-W)</sup> 2 x 3 m. in dimension. It has a looters pit on its SE corner. The elevation of this structure is less than 50 cm and it is constructed of cobbles.
- #8 One of the larger structures on the SE side of the site. This mound is a <sup>(E-W) (N-S)</sup> 5 x 3 m. in dimension and is constructed of river cobbles, its <sup>elevation</sup> is ~~about~~ 1 m.
