General beginning notes: A long (WE) flat structure. The mound, ^{rising} not more than 50cm above orig G.S. The structure is similarly constructed to #20. And can be compared w/ those buildings around Area 2 b/c of the small rock overlying layer. I would term it a terrace/platform now, ~~but~~ it may have been a storage area for the Indians. The paucity of sherds throughout indicates little as an activity area. Yet the BE basewall is w/in 40m to the ^E. Construction throughout is uniform.

A lens of small cobble and ~~the~~ w/ large bobbles below. The BT/19-22 1x1m telephone booth trench on the summit (p90-26-21) indicates that a lens of 30cm ^{deep} of dark grey (very organic or just at one time?) soil was laid down to make the mound.

The excavations outside the mound show the dark grey lens tapering off ~~a~~ about 1m from the edges of the building (caught in profiles) map here of ~~the~~ W side of N end of BY sub op

Architecture

This is a rectangular structure oriented (WE) with no walls named. All four corners are excavated, and as can be expected only one is in good shape.
