

NOTES ON Censer Bases

Basically there are two forms: one base that is rounded and another that is straight. Hence, there were most likely two basic forms. One that was square or rectangular and another that was in the shape of a circle. The square bases look sort of like  and round ones look like . The body  and the base .

The straight ones are fewer in number than the rounded bases. Out of the three straight bases one is painted orange and it also has an applied strip running just above the base. The other two are also painted with a orange slip but they don't have the same size as the first one. Out of the two smaller ones one also has an applied strip right above the base. Two of the bases also finishing marks on the inside. Go figure? It should be noted the orange slip is on the inside as well as the outside. Inside also has evidence of burning.

Round Bases can be broken up into painted and non-painted (some with divisions in each). There is range of paste color found in the non-painted bases. The past for non-painted ranges from a black paste to a light brown to a orangish brown paste. There are a few non-painted bases that have matt-impressions on them.



There are a few base fragments that have finishing touches on them. Matt impressions are found on bases with the orangish brown paste while the finishing lines are found base with a light brown paste. Finishing lines are also found on fragments with orangish brown paste. The point being, no matt impressions have been found on base fragments with the light-brown paste. Only finishing lines. The black paste fragments do not have either finishing lines or matt impressions.

The painted bases also have a range of paste. The paste ranges from a black to a light brown to an orangish-brown (Burnt orange). Several Bases have matte impressions and finishing lines. Several of the Black bases have matte impressions.

Pieces with range paste have matt impressions and finishing lines. Some of the range pottery with finishing lines has red paint on it.

Blacks with matt impressions has red paint on it.

Painted Base - A lot of the Black Bases have red lines running vertical up the Base  Bases. Some Black Bases are painted red surface.

Several black Paste Bases have orangish-red paint on the inside. It should be noted that there are some Black paste bases that have red paint but no matt impressions or finishing lines.
