This is a rim - wall base from a bowl-style censer or plain section of a modeled censer.

The interior is - is not striated vertically - horizontally - in various directions.

The interior is also smoothed - irregular - undulating - rough - cracked - gouged - pitted - fireclouded, and/or has "wet-look" finger marks - clay scraps - mat marking clay lip around hole.

The exterior is - is not striated vertically - horizontally - in various directions.

The exterior is also smoothed - irregular - undulating - rough - cracked - gouged - pitted - fireclouded, and/or has clay from attachment(s) - "wet-look" finger marks - clay scraps - mat marking.
