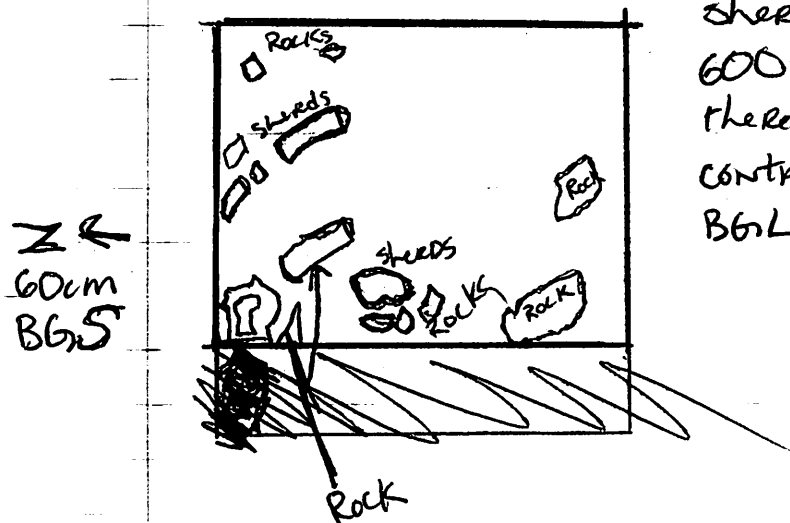

FINAL NOTES

THIS TP was dug almost 60cm down where we reached a possible surface floor with sherds and came to a soil level where river cobbles began to appear (3 level). lot 03/04 we used 4 lots to separate this TP ~~into~~ one for each 20cm down and a 4th for the surface found at the bottom of the test pit. sherds were found and collected from each level.

SITE CONSISTS OF 5 MOUNDS MADE OF MEDIUM TO LARGE ANGULAR ROCKS used for hills. (Limestone) structure visibility is ~~good~~ ^{fair} surface visibility is POOR. Ground cover is medium scrub growth. A few small trees are growing on and around the structures. Structures are well preserved. Structure 3 has a tree growing from the top structure 2 has a tree on the South side. Structure 2 has a partial terrace.

This site is 300 meters through the hill to the south of site 414. a large hill stands to the north between the sites. The structures sit on a rise ~~that~~ that slopes steeply down 2 meters on the North side of the site.

There are hills directly to the south at the edge of the site approx. 25 meters from transit. The hill separating 414 from 415 to the North is 100 meters away. to North.
