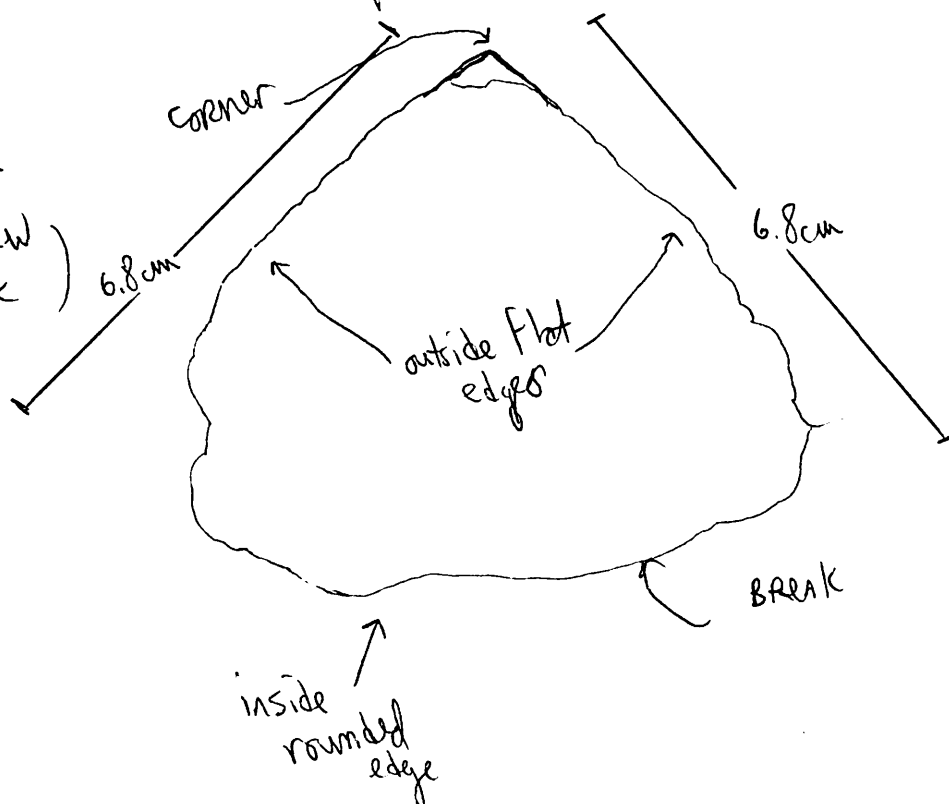

Verbal Description

Metate leg and grinding base fragment — top surface very worn/smooth and flat; leg although ground, is still somewhat rough. Outside edges flat and meet at an acute angle, inside edge is very rounded. Break is on inside edge-top, where the leg meets the trough. The break is worn smooth (probably broken in antiquity). This appears to be a corner piece of the metate.
