~~Diameter~~ Diameter varies from 3.27cm x 4.47cm at the broken end to 3.54cm x 3.88cm at the finished end.

This is a smoother of very small mano, made on tuff & white with gray, black, and brown inclusions. One facet of the side is flat across, but slightly concave end-to-end. It has a protruding inclusion that is harder than the tuff, and really isn't worn down. I also think this facet has fine, shallow, side-to-side striations, especially in the middle. The rest of the side is rounded, lightly ground, but not flat, rather undulating. One end appears finished, and may be abraded on one side from use. The other end is broken, with the edges rounded off, suggesting continued use after breakage.
