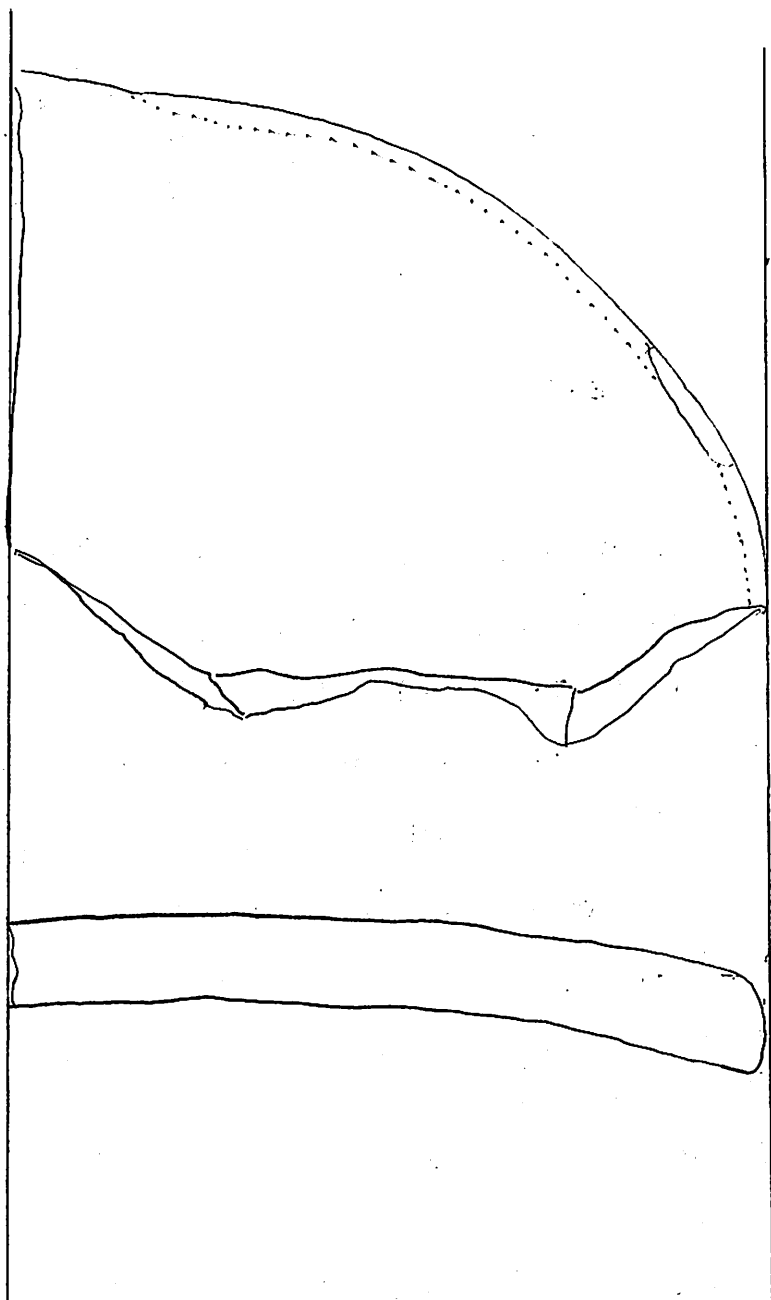

Verbal Description

A sherd smoother made on a large, thick piece of Sicora (with fairly high amounts of large white inclusions, up to 0.3 cm), ~~gray~~ ^{colored} dark gray to black throughout. There are two unfinished/unused edges. One is straight, while the other has 3 facets. The used edge is for the most part round, although it departs from a circle at one end. This, and the lack of wear on this straighter portion, makes me think that this was never a disk. There are longitudinal and lateral curves. Wear has made the curved edge rounded in ~~the~~ cross-section. Nonetheless, some of the marks of how the sherd was clipped into a round shape remain.
