Verbal Description

Slightly off-round, medium-sized sherd disk, probably made on a Jicaro. The item is thoroughly burnt -- only ~~the~~ less than 1 mm of the exterior surface is not gray to black, and it is a dark tan. The piece looks like the initial shape was outlined by scoring the sherd exterior, after which chipping and grinding were used to finish the shape. Evidence of chipping is still visible. The edge is rounder on the exterior surface than on the interior.
