VERBAL DESCRIPTION:

Step fragments rectangular in shape no edges are notched  
Design is step lots of spiral tails connected to a stair element in the middle.

The edges are rough & cracked - this is not one of the better made specimens I  
have ever seen. The edges of the stamp are wavy. Back is not well smoothed - Surface

undulate & some finger smoothing is visible. 5 stamp edges are cut, but do not bevel on  
the back. Handle is broken & stamp is probably 3/4 complete.
