Verbal Description:

fragment of a multi-chamber candelero with evidence of at least 4 chambers (I feel that it may have only ever had 4 and may have been roughly square) The chamber walls are basically smooth + curved with roughly ~~smoothed~~ flat bottoms the chambers are very burnt especially toward the bottom with fire cloudy more toward the top. The exterior surface is roughly smoothed and has incision in in the form of 3 parallel vertical shallowly incised lines.



There is a button like flat

bottom nubbin foot at the bottom of one of the chambers it shows evidence of wear.
