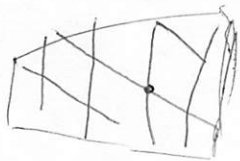

Verbal Description: fragment of a multichamber candelero with one complete chamber and evidence of at least 4 more. The ~~one~~ chamber walls are fairly smooth + curved with slightly rounded bottoms. They are very burnt for the bottom 2/3 of the chamber and fireclouded in the upper 1/3. The top "central plug" is smooth + flat. Exterior walls are well smoothed and incised with a thin cross hatch type design.



There is some very slight fireclouding on the vessel exterior.

The wall turns a smooth rounded corner at one of the vent walls there is also at this turn a small slightly worn nubbin foot and just past the turn 1/2 way up the wall a tiny rnd vent hole.

even though the Paste is A the piece has a somewhat crude feel to it.
