"Black Bird" was a possible earlier foundation. It turns north at (13) where Crow turns south". Crow, at the same level, heads east out of the pit.

First Altar runs (2-10) to (5) where it seems to end, heads north to (24) the e.w. again to (4). Drawing imaginary lines south from (4) & west from (3) would complete a square. Perhaps this inset area was used as an entrance, as would be evidenced by the level of rocks along "east line" or perhaps served as a place to secure a corner post.

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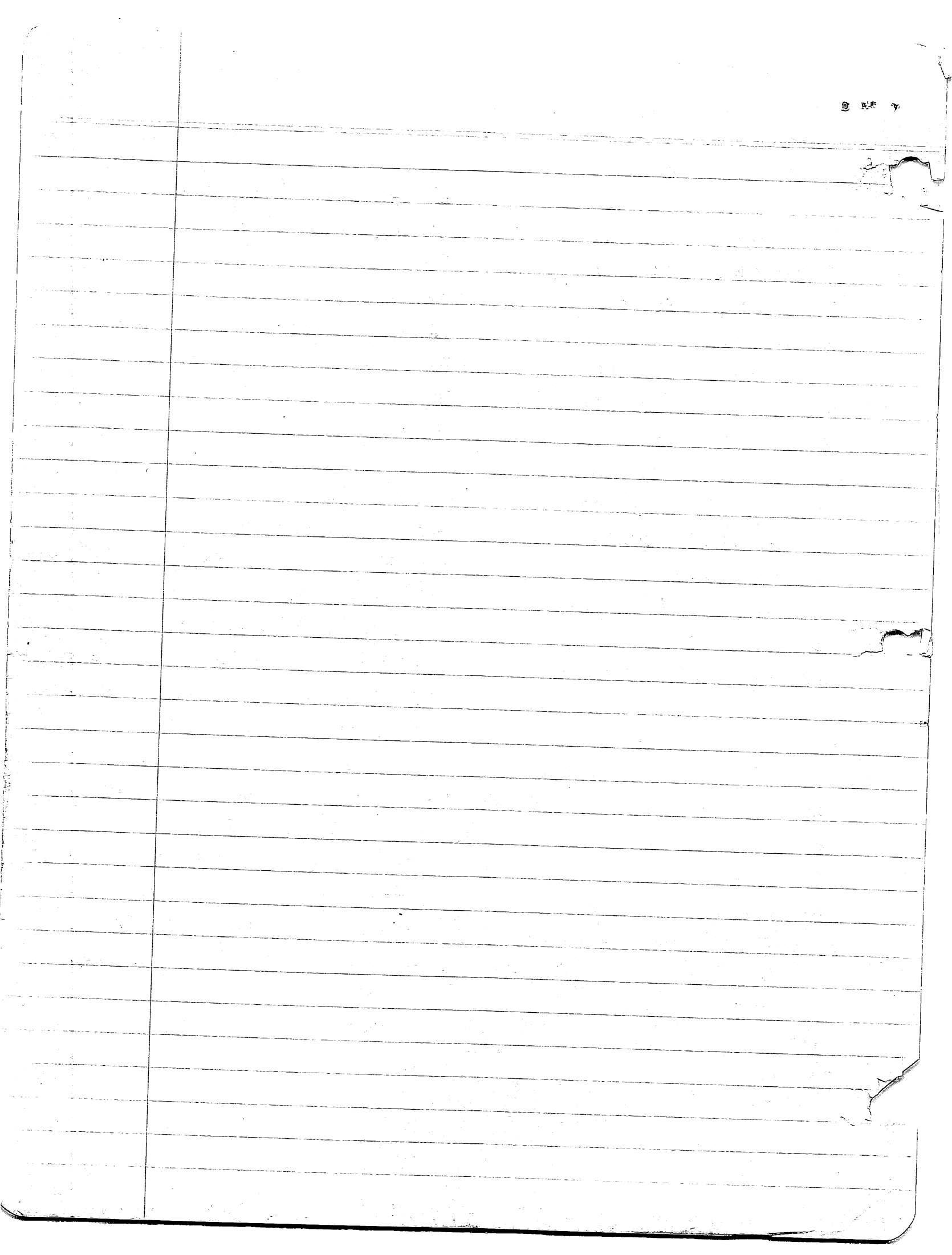
