EARSPOOLS: ON EITHER SIDE OF HEAD, .8cm ACROSS W/INCISED HOLE

BEAK: 1.4cm LONG x 1.0cm TALL x .7cm THICK. INCISED LINES ON EITHER SIDE .3cm WIDEX 1cm LONG.

ALSO A PAIR OF INCISED HOLES AT THE BREAK TO THE NECK .4cm ACROSS

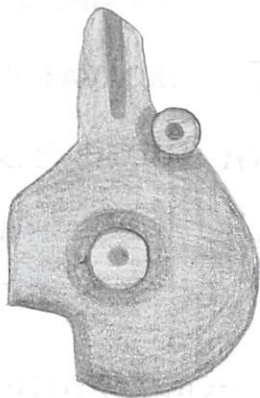
