VERBAL DESCRIPTION: This is a complete - incomplete multi-chamber ocarina.

There are parts of at least 3 chambers preserved.

Chamber diameters are: 1.85; 1.85; 3.05

There are chamber connecting holes preserved. Their diameters are:

The seams on the chambers: are - are not visible. How many chambers broke along their seams?

The envelope of clay around the chambers: is - is not visible. The envelope averages how much in thickness?

There are 4 fingering holes preserved. Their diameters are: .5; .5; .5; .5

The decorative or figurative portion of the ocarina: is - is not preserved.

The main part of the decorative portion is: hand modeled - molded.

There: are - are not appliqueed portions. Describe:

The exterior shows the following treatments: incision - excision - applique - slip - paint - smoothing - burnishing - polishing - other (describe). Slip and/or paint colors are (Munsell designations):

Slip color: 10R 4/8

Describe the figurative or decorative portion of the exterior:

Human figure with an elaborate headdress & ear spools. No arms. Horizontal projections coming off headdress on both sides of headdress. Rectangular feet. Projection on back of that is round with a hole in the middle.

The exterior shows the following manufacturing marks: none - smoothing - wiping - finger smears - finger prints - scraping - striations - lumps of clay - seams from molding - trimming - other (describe).

There: are - are not legs present. If present: number - 2 size - .5 Long / 1.35 wide

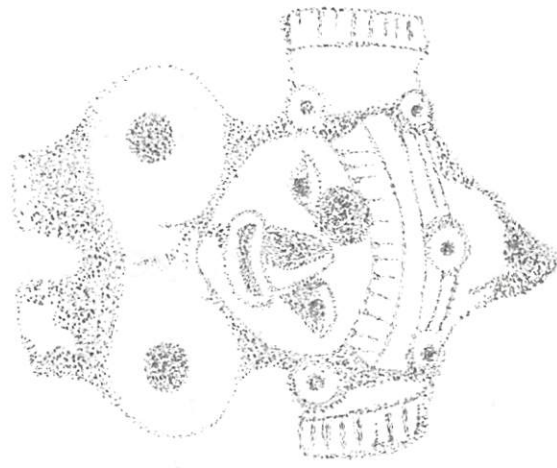
What is the shape of the legs (e.g., conical, truncated cone, slab, rectangle): rectangular, short
