Additional descriptive comments on figurative or decorative portion of the exterior:

HEAD FRAGMENT, SOLID. HEADDRESS, EYES, NOSE & MOUTH, AS WELL AS A PORTION OF THE LEFT EARSPPOOL REMAIN. THERE ARE 2 JOINED FRAGMENTS AS THE PIECE BROKE POST-PROCESSING (BREAK DOWN RIGHT SIDE HEADDRESS). THE SPACE BETWEEN THE BASE OF THE HEADDRESS AND FACE IS QUITE BROAD (1.6cm TALL). HEADDRESS IS 2.3cm TALL & FACE IS 2.4cm TALL. HEADDRESS

The item is: not eroded - slightly - moderately - very - extremely eroded. IS A PLAIN BAND.

EYES ARE INCISED SLASHES .7cm LONG x .5cm HIGH WITH EXTRA INCISION JUST OUTSIDE (ON BOTH SIDES OF THE FACE) AS FACE PAINT OR TATTOOING (.3cm x .2cm) THE MOUTH IS BROKEN ALONG THE LOWER LIP, OBSCURING DETAILS. NOSE IS SMALL AND AQUILINE (1.6cm LONG x .8cm WIDE x 1cm THICK). ~~A~~ THE UPPER HALF OF THE LEFT EARSPOND IS PRESERVED.
