LEFT SIDE FRAGMENT OF AN EARSPPOOL AND SHOULDER/ARM. EARSPPOOL IS UNUSUAL - A CIRCULAR RAISED CLAY BUTTON (1.6cm ACROSS) WITH 5 INCISED HOLES  (CENTER HOLE .3cm ACROSS, SIDE HOLES .2cm ACROSS). THE SHOULDER IS BROAD AND ROUNDED AND BEARS A RAISED, STIPPLED DECORATION (ARM BAND?) PART WAY DOWN (JUST AT THE BREAK) ON THE INTERIOR FINGER PRINTS AN NAIL MARKS ARE CLEARLY PRONOUNCED
