THE EYES ARE INCISED IN 2 SLASHES ON EACH SIDE W/THE RAISED AREA BETWEEN SERVING AS PUPILS. NOSE IS 1.3cm LONG x .8cm TALL (OFF FACE) x .9cm WIDE.
