FRAGMENT OF A FACE W/ RIGHT EYE, NOSE, AND MOUTH PRESERVED. EYE IS 1.1cm LONG AND WAS MADE BY A SINGLE INCISION. THE NOSE IS VERT LARGE, ~~ROUGH~~ 1.9cm LONG x 1.5cm WIDE THERE WERE NO NOSTRILS AND A BIT OF RED PAINT IS PRESERVED ON THE UNDERSIDE OF THE NOSE. WIDE MARKS WHERE CLAY WAS SMOOTHED UP ONTO THE NOSE WHEN IT WAS ATTACHED

THE MOUTH INCLUDES RAISED LIPS AND TWO INCISED TEETH. THE MOUTH MEASURES 2.2cm ACROSS x 1.3cm TALL. THE LIPS ARE .4cm THICK. THE TEETH HAVE THEIR OUTER, LOWER SECTIONS INCISED AWAY → . THE HEAD WOULD HAVE BEEN HOLLOW.
