SMALL FRAGMENT OF WHAT MAY BE A HEAD (THERE IS AN INCISED FLARE/FLANGE VISIBLE). THE INCISIONS ARE ON EITHER SIDE OF THE FLANGE (WHICH ITSELF IS 2.3cm LONG x 1cm TALL x .9cm WIDE). THERE ARE 3 INCISIONS PRESERVED ON ONE SIDE OF THE FLANGE & 4 ON THE OTHER (ON AVG. ^{1cm} WIDE x .7cm LONG AND .3cm APART).

The item is: not eroded - slightly - moderately - very - extremely eroded. AN INCISION ALSO RUNS THE LENGTH OF THE RIDGE OF THE FLANGE.

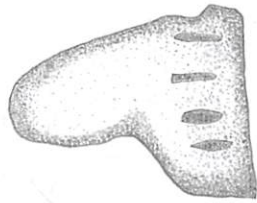
