This is a small, thin fragment of a ~~figurine~~ decorative portion of a figurine. It seems to have been a collar of beads signified by circles with holes in their centers. There's another ridge below this and another circle, which may be some sort of costume decoration. This piece, by its color + paste, seems to have been part of the same figurine as 202BU/002-1, 2, and 3, but it doesn't articulate with any of them. It was probably part of a hollow figurine, when complete.

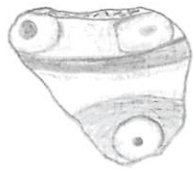
