Additional descriptive comments on figurative or decorative portion of the exterior:

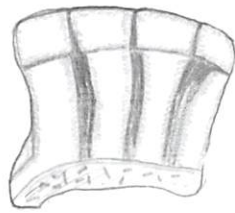
This piece is a flared projection off of some part of a figurine, but it is unclear which part. It is made up of four long pieces with wider square parts on the ends. Unlike 202BU/002-2, this piece seems to have been part of a hollow figurine, rather than applied on. It may have been part of the same figurine as 202BU/002-1 and 2, because it's the same paste + similar style, though much less detailed. This is a headdress stamp.
